Sessions and modules

There are four study sessions in a year, each lasting 10 weeks and followed by an assessment submission point. Sessions begin in October, January, April and July, and these starting months are given above in the Session and Resit session columns to represent the session span.

Please note: some modules will launch in a different session to the session in which they will usually run. For example, PMM030 Information Technology Project Management will launch, and is available for registrations, in April 2022. It will then run in January 2023 and each January session thereafter.

Modules that run in the October or April sessions are also available for study on a stand-alone basis, excluding the PMM500 Project module.

Modules will run according to the timetable above (subject to minimum student registrations and availability). In exceptional circumstances we may consider deferring a module to a later session, or offer a different module in its place. We will inform you of any such changes as early as possible and provide you with reasonable alternative arrangements.

Resit opportunity

Where a module is failed, students will have an opportunity to resit only the failed assessment, as opposed to repeating the module in full. Students who are eligible for a resit opportunity will be prompted when registration opens for the resit. The resit must be taken in the first available session, given in the resit session column above, otherwise the module should be repeated in full when it runs again. Assessments are typically in week six (where there is a mid-session assessment) and week 12, although specific dates will be provided after registration. The resit and module fees (applicable when a module is repeated) can be found in the **fee schedule**.
